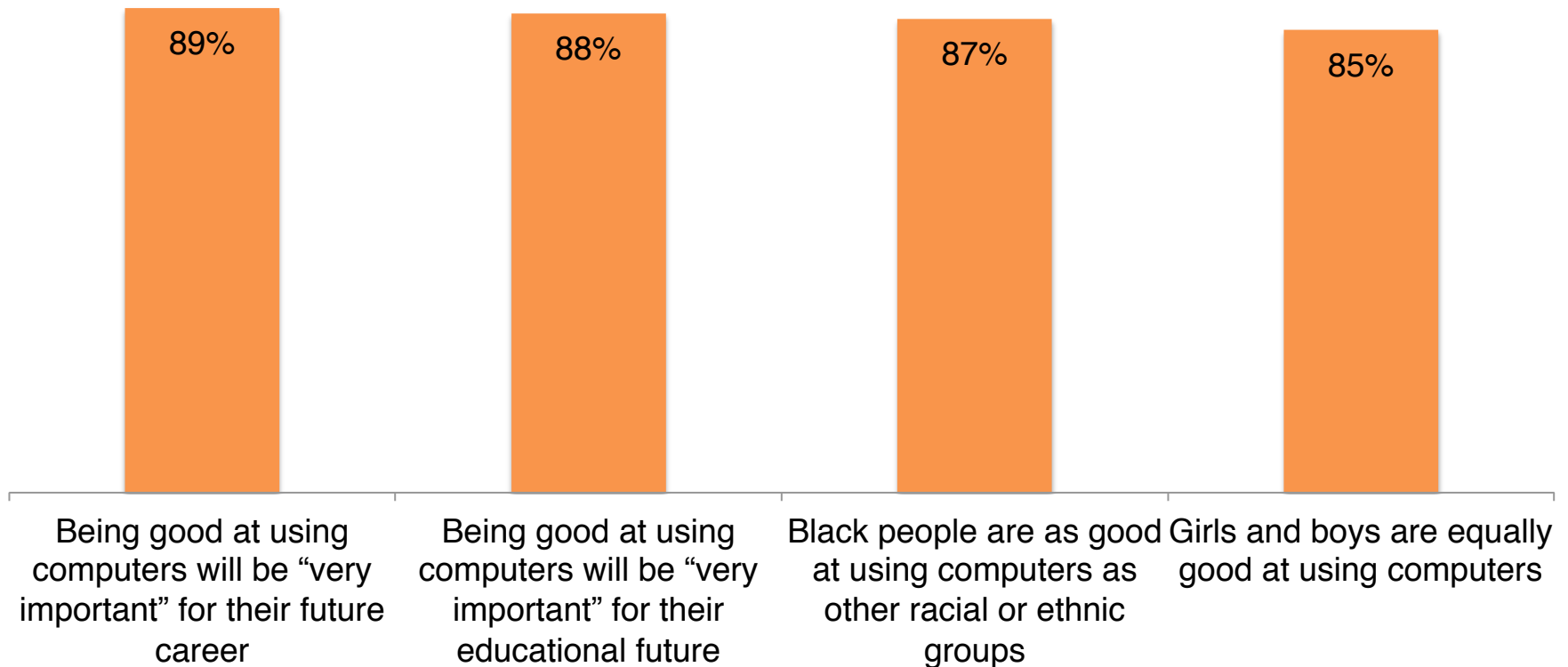


Key Finding #10
